Gratitude

That is one of first words that comes to me when I think about my time spent as a resident at FDC. I will be forever grateful to the staff (Dennis) and the committee for accepting me into the program.

With the help and patience of the wonderful teachers and counselors, I came back from a world of darkness to a world filled with love and grace. And being freely given these, I have been able to show this love and grace to others who needed them at least as much as I needed them.

I have been blessed with opportunities to come back to the Center. These times give Dennis a break and my wife (LeAnn). Sometimes she will even help me pack!!!! She has never once said that I could not go. She knows how important it is for me to be around people like me. I don't know what it is -- I go to Bible study here, I go to my AA meetings, I go to Sunday School and Church here. But coming back to the Center and seeing Dennis and the friends I have made here gives me a kind of peace that is different!

I know that getting sober is never easy. I also know that staying sober is a lot harder than people think it is! While trying to stay sober and something goes awry, the natural thing for alcoholics or addicts to do is to default back to what would have been done in the past --- drink or use. It is at this point in time when prayer and picking up the phone to call someone who has been in this situation allows you to come out the other side sober! Staying clean and sober while at the Center isn't too difficult. It's when a person goes back out into the world where it gets tough!

Most of us alcoholics and addicts think we are tough! In reality we are childish, self-centered and over sensitive. Some of us harbor secrets that we feel can never be shared with anyone. I believe in the 12 steps of Celebrate Recovery. I believe that if a person can take the time to be honest and work through these steps, they will come out of the other side a new person!

I know that being a resident I learned a lot about and developed a relationship with my Lord Jesus Christ! All one has to do is open ones heart and mind and you can get that! For myself it is not enough! Maybe I need help with my unbelief! I don't know! But for me I know that I need to be around people like me. I need to be around people who have some of the same thoughts that I have (good or bad). I get that at AA meetings and by coming back to the Center.

Staying clean and sober is not an easy thing. But given the right tools and learning how to use them; and developing a relationship with our Lord makes it possible.

Since I've been here at FDC I've met a lot of good people who run the program, the other residents and members of the Evangelical Free Church here in Oelwein. I've learned a lot about the Bible with three plus classes daily. One thing I learned is to put others needs before mine. I lived a lot of years with a selfish spirit not

thinking of others. Now I want to serve others and be God's hands and feet where ever needed. I learned if I draw near to God, He will draw near to me and this crowds out the evil one! The word evil means the absence of good. I draw close to Him by reading the Bible to know His Word and by praying. But knowing the Word isn't enough to change the heart, it happens only by the Spirit of God that resides in me. Thank you Jesus! Now I use the life Jesus lived on earth as an example of how to live my life! I've learned that prayer is a powerful thing. I prayed for God to provide a car for me and three months later that prayer was answered! I also prayed that God would restore my relationship with my ex-wife, but Gods answer to that was no. I would never discredit my ex because there is a lot of good in her and she is a good mother to our daughter. God knows what we need and when we need it.
